

## WEYBRIDGE ROWING CLUB

### CAPTAIN

**Summary:** The Captain is leader of the Club and is responsible for training, coaching and representation of the Club in competitions. Specific duties include.

#### **Accountable and Responsible for:-**

- Manage boat allocation and usage
- Ensure training sessions are managed and that all club members have access to planned training programmes
- Attend WRC Committee Meetings (monthly), highlighting relevant activities.
- Ensure coaching programme is managed, matching crews to available coaches.
- Co-ordinate recreational rowing with the Captain of Weyfarers RC.
- Report progress against development, coaching and training plans to Committee meetings and AGM.
- Report progress against plan for equipment refurbishment, replacement and new purchases.
- Prepare rolling plan for equipment refurbishment and purchase of new equipment with the Vice Captains.
- Organise the Hyne Cup once every 2 years.
- Coordinate equipment repair in line with plan
- Ensure that all active users of club equipment are paid-up members (in conjunction with Treasurer / Secretary / Junior Coordinator/Vice Captains).
- Advise the Committee on boat racking of members' private boats
- Adjudicate the timetable of land based programmes either at Circuits or Clubhouse.
- Maintain and display the following lists (in accordance with Club Safety Brochure):
  - Members who hold a Certificate of Watermanship (authorised Risk Assessors)
  - Club Coaches (authorised Risk Assessors; some will also be Authorised Adults)
  - Authorised Adults
- Participate in recruiting new members
- Meet, greet and encourage new members

The Captain may appoint up to 3 Vice Captains from the committee members elected at the AGM.

The Captain is one of the 3 Principal Club Officers (Rule 8).
